COUNTY RECREATION FUND CONTRIBUTION UNDER PAR

Torrance's share of county recreation funds is considerably less than the city is entitled to.

Torrance, with an operating cost of \$51,668 receives \$4822 from the county. South Pasadena with an operation of \$41,446 receives \$7234; Lynwood, with a \$53,083 operation gets \$15,233; Manhattan Beach with only \$19,510 operating costs receives \$3000; Santa Monica with a \$53,800 operation receives \$13,450.

Pasadena is considered the ideal standard. County recreation funds amount to one third of the operating costs. Pasadena's operating cost is \$192,136. It receives \$61,844 from the county.

Harry Van Bellehem, director of recreation for the city of Torrance, declared this week that he would continue fighting for additional county recreation funds to which the city is entitled.

The city, which had \$1396.25 of its \$4822 county fund restored this month after the money had been lopped off, had requested an additional \$3133.15 which the county denied.

Torrance is one of 15 cities and 13 school districts which had deducted recreation funds restored following protests by the Pasadena School District and the city.
