Games Champ To be Chosen At El Nido



New Drive-In to Have 3-Day Grand Opening

John C. Feys, well known theatre operator, announces the opening on August 24 of a new drive-in theatre for the Anaheim-Lakewood area, the Lincoln Drive-In, at 6612 Lincoln Avenue in Anaheim. Feys is president of the Lincoln Theatre Corporation and the Great Western Theaters, Inc., owners and operators of the Harbor Drive-In Theatre in Torrance.

After a three-day grand opening, the drive-in will continue to operate on a two-change policy, changing programs on Sundays and Wednesdays. For the benefit of the children, there will be two color cartoons on each program.

New Screen
Feys says the drive-in represents an investment of \$200,000. The drive-in is the first in California to be equipped with the new and revolutionary big picture evaluate screen which will project pictures up to a 2-1 ratio.

A member of Feys' organization, a well known screen personality in his own right, Joseph "Joe" Greene, will also be active in the drive-in's operations. Feys encourages Greene's picture career. Greene is at present operating the Harbor Drive-In in Torrance.

Few people attending the drive-in are aware that the manager is a screen personality. In addition to running the drive-in, Greene is busy making pictures in Hollywood and appearing on television.

Known to movie-goers the world over, he has played in numerous roles and is probably best known for his portrayal of the sheriff in the Hopalong Cassidy series.

He has been in the movies about twelve years for Universal, Republic, 20th Century-Fox, Monogram and Paramount. His most recent roles are the part of Diamond Jim Brady in "Apache" starring Burt Lancaster and as an actor's agent in the soon to be released Judy Garland picture, "A Star is Born."

In the television field, Greene has appeared with Alan Young's TV show, the "Wild Bill Hickock" series, "Boston Blackie," "Public Prosecutor" and "Racket Squad." With this colorful background, he should know his movies, Feys said.
