New Simplified Postal Regulations Available

Torrance Postmaster Clara A. Conner today called to the attention of mail users major new postal regulations being issued effective December 1 which will provide important changes and simplification in the use of the mails.

The Post Office Department is issuing a final edition of a history-making new Postal Manual which contains these changes in simple form. The new manual will bring together in less than 300 pages postal information formerly scattered through 4000 pages of dense print, Postmaster Conner explained.

Mail users anxious to keep abreast of all changes in this material that may be made from time may get both the pamphlet in loose-leaf format and a year's subscription to all sheets making changes for a total of \$2, also from the Superintendent of Documents, the postmaster noted.

The revision of the Postal Manual, Postmaster Clara A. Conner said, represents what Postmaster General Arthur E. Summerfield has described the most complete revision of regulations in the history of the U.S. Post Office Department.

"The new publication is remarkable for its simplicity," Mrs. Conner said. "Not only is it printed in easy-to-understand English, but it contains simple black and white illustrations on how to prepare material for mailing. The print is easy to understand, and is arranged in logical sections under bold-face headings."



US Chamber Representative Addresses Businessmen Here

A four-point blueprint for action by business men designed to encourage investment, create jobs, and expand production, was offered Torrance Chamber of Commerce at Tuesday's Community Breakfast by Walter W. Underwood of the Chamber of Commerce of the United States.

Underwood is District Manager with headquarters in Los Angeles.

The blueprint recommends:
1. Close study of national affairs by business men so they can offer informed, constructive opinion both to Congress and citizens of this community.
2. An intensified program of economics study by Chamber members led by top executives in the community.
3. Invitation of school teachers to visit local business and industrial firms, so they can give first hand knowledge of

the community's economic resources.

4. Distribution by the Chamber of Commerce of the technical film "It's Everybody's Business" to every citizen's organization in the community.

Accomplishments
