This change was necessary due to the muddy condition of the park. However, Evelyn Carr Elementary school will have a recreation program on Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Walteria park program at night will be discontinued for the same reason of mud, however, there will be a program there every afternoon from 4 p.m. until 6 p.m. Also, in the Walteria area there will be a program carried on at the Walteria school on Saturdays only from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Changes Necessary: These changes listed above were made necessary because of the lack of adequate facilities on which to carry on a recreation program during the cold, wet, winter months. Seaside school will continue with the same after-school program as carried on throughout the fall months from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. with no program on Saturdays.
