

You see, the other preacher quit, just walked out, so "Preacher" and I worked together, bringing in stones, boards and nails. Folks would say, "Where is the Preacher?" I would reply, "He is out rolling up building material every day..."

Things are running along very good but right here I would like to say that I firmly believe if we could join some large well-established church it would be better for all concerned...

Groups and members of a small church like this one feel some superman heading - the church is the answer they hope for... that such a leader will relieve them of responsibilities and give them an authority by which to live. It never works. No man is wise enough to make the decisions for a people but more important no man is good enough to wield such power...
