Employers, Union Sign New Contract

In a joint statement, commenting upon the settlement of the mercantile agreement with Retail Clerks Local 905 for a two year period, with no wage increase this year, Ben N. Scott, acting secretary-treasurer of Local 905, and Frenk S. Selover, executive secretary of the Harbor Area Employers' Council, said that the "settlement reflects new gains in harmonious labor-management relations in the Harbor area, and points to the fact that both management and labor agree that industrial stability is a keynote to a prosperous community."
The only change in the contract which had an anniversary date of February 3, 1955, is that employees who have had seven years continuous service with an employer will be entitled to three weeks' paid vacation annually. While the present new agreement will run until February 3, 1957, it may be re-opened on February 3, 1956, for negotiations of hours and wages only.

The agreement covers some 700 employees of retail establishments in the harbor area. Employees of drug stores, variety stores, shoe stores, food stores and liquor stores are under separate contracts.



would provide parking spaces for 31 cars at a time, are located on Gramercy ave., Marcelina st., Engracia ave., Border ave. and Cabrillo ave. Three of the sites now have houses on them that would have to be razed or moved.

Carson st. and Border ave. Rippey said the committee recommended that a total of 25 meters be installed on the lots nearest the main body of stores. Some of the meters would permit all-day parking for 25-cents.
Revenues from the meters would be used to retire the 20-year bonds.
