A year ago, she decided to tear down the old cafe and concentrate on building a modern restaurant, based on an idea

never used before. Calling upon the talent of Elinor Hufty, prominent portrait artist and mural specialist, Mrs. Overpeck designed her restaurant with a medieval setting in mind.


