#### Expansion

Hinckley's now offers more than 50,000 individual items, 9000 foot floor space, and 25 additional display areas featuring expanded lines of nationally advertised food products.

Isles have been widened two feet, a complete new lighting system has been installed, three check stands are now available, and the frontage on Narbonne avenue has been increased by 100 feet.

A large parking area is available for the convenience of shoppers.

"We have undertaken this expansion in order to bring Torrance and Lomita residents a complete supermarket with a

#### Prizes

#### Background

Hinckley's market was founded by Mrs. Elizabeth Hinckley more than 25 years ago on the principles of friendly hometown service, competitive prices, and a complete stock of merchandise.

These principles will be carried out by Mrs. Hinckley's son, Tom, who has assumed active management of the store.

Third proprietor of the market is Kenneth Hinckley, husband of Mrs. Elizabeth Hinckley.

Mr. and Mrs. Hinckley came to Lomita in 1924 and built their first market across the street from the present one.

It was sold when the Hinckley's went into the restaurant business, only to reestablish the market later at the present location.

Mrs. Hinckley has been active in civic affairs for many years and has been associated with the South Bay Civic Opera association.

Tom Hinckley attended school locally, graduating from Narbonne in 1941. He served as a radio operator gunner in the U. S. Air Force for 3½ years during World War II and as chemist at Columbia Steel before taking over the management of the market in 1947.




