Committees To Iron Out Differences On Supermart

Residents along Atkinson ave. and officials of the Foods Co. supermarket being erected at 174th st. and Crenshaw blvd. will try to settle their differences at a meeting this week.

This decision was reached Tuesday night when the City Council suggested that the two groups try to straighten out their problems in this manner and then report back to the Council.

Traffic Cited

The issue flared up last week when residents complained to the Council that heavy traffic will come down residential streets endangering small children.

Norman Bruffy, speaking for the residents, stated that the original plans for the market showed a closed cement wall around the parking lot as far

as residential streets are concerned.

However, at present there are two driveways leading directly onto Atkinson, Bruffy said. It was also pointed out that a sidewalk, originally proposed, was missing.

Three years ago Mrs. Levesque's home at 1916 West 236th street, was badly damaged by fire. Mrs. Levesque, who was just returning home, saw the building ablaze while firemen were trying to extinguish the blaze.

Terrified, she recalled that one of her children might be trapped in the bedroom. When firemen were informed of this, they rushed into the flaming house, disregarding their own safety.

It turned out that the child had left the house just a few
