Supports Rabies Law

Enclosed you will find my coupon approving of a compulsory rabies law, which I consider should not be only a city law but a law for the whole country.
I have two children, a boy, Brett, who is six, and a little girl, Geraldyn, who will soon be two years.
We also have a young cocker spaniel who is going to receive his rabies shots as soon as he is old enough to receive them.
I realize the importance of such a law as my son was bitten on the face in three places by a neighbor's dog when he was three.
He received only one Pasteur

shot as a precaution while the dog was under observation—and that was enough!
After seeing this shot given we decided to wait out the quarantine period rather than to subject the child to such painful treatment.
Fortunately the dog was not rabid, which was an answer to our prayer.
I don't think the majority of people realize how painful the Pasteur treatment is or how painful the disease itself is, not only for the person bitten but also for the dog.
Anyone with an ounce of human kindness cannot stand to see an animal suffer, let alone one of their own children.
This is the reason that my children's dog, "Freckles," is going to receive his rabies shots as soon as he is old enough.
By doing this I will save the dog a lot of suffering. I also will have peace of mind knowing that our dog will not give my children rabies or any of the children who live close to us.
I think it will be wonderful to say, if our dog bites anyone, which I hope doesn't happen, that our dog was taken care of by having his rabies shots.
This I feel is our obligation to the dog as it is our obligation to take care of our children's health.
You may use my name in connection with any approval of this law which I hope will soon be compulsory, even though I will have taken care of our dog before that time... Thank you very much for reading my letter and thank you for taking such an interest in this law.

I see a man has just died from a rattle snake bite in Palm Springs, let's get busy and vaccinate all rattle snakes so this will not happen again.
In the forty years I have been associated with the medical profession I have said if people would feed or water any poor little lost dog in the hot weather the rabies scare would be nil.
We vote people into good jobs and as soon as they are settled they try to foist some racket on us, in collusion with some paper, but if they would only look at the experiences of others they would see it didn't pay.
We citizens of Torrance do not want the rabies law enacted or brought before the people.
