Designed by Torrance City Engineer Ronald W. Bishop, the project is scheduled to receive final approval of the board of supervisors within two weeks, Supervisor Hahn said.

Allocated \$362,600 in the bond issue, the drain will be constructed in two sections. One section will be built along Arlington from Redondo Beach boulevard to Dominguez channel, while the other section will be along Glenburn from approximately 175th street to Dominguez channel.

\$10,000
The agreement for the relocation of street lighting and traffic control devices was approved at the request of the City of Torrance, Supervisor Hahn said, and calls for the City to do the work and be reimbursed by the Flood Control District up to a maximum of \$10,000.

Supervisor Hahn pointed out that all bond issue storm drains are regional in character, using reinforced concrete pipe or box conduits five feet or more in diameter. Maximum efficiency of these drains can be attained by the local communities affected by construction of the necessary auxiliary laterals to the main drains.




