### Restocking Lakes And Streams With Trout

This week the following Southern California lakes and streams are scheduled to be restocked with catchable-size trout by the department of fish and game:

yon creek, Fulmore lake, Hemet lake.  
 San Bernardino County: Forsee creek, Green Valley lake, Jenks lake, Mill creek, Mountain Home creek, Middle Fork Lytle creek, North Fork Lytle creek, Rainbow lake (on upper Deep Creek), Santa Ana river.  
 Ventura County: Matilija reservoir, North Fork Ventura river, lower Sespe creek.  
**NEARS PEAK**  
 Big trout-planting push for 1955 is now on in the Inyo-Mono

country where the department of fish and game will stock roadside waters with a million catchable-size rainbow during the peak vacation months of July and August. Streams in the area are past their annual run-off peak and are now in first-class condition for both planting and fishing.  
 Following is a report on current fishing quality on some of Inyo-Mono's most popular roadside waters:  
 South lake, so low during early season that a planting truck couldn't get to it, has more water now, has been planted and is providing good fishing. Should be good through early September. Sebrina lake, fair to good in early season, is much better now with water level rising.  
 Rock Creek lake has been good throughout season, with Convict lake fair. June lake has ranged all the way from poor to excellent. Silver Lake, slow in early season due to cold water, should be at its best from here on for rainbow and big browns. Grant Lake good for both rainbow and browns up to 3 pounds.  
 Twin Lakes Mammoth good to excellent, with Mary Lake rated good. Upper Twin lake Bridgeport excellent. Lower Twin good and Robinson creek very good. Bridgeport reservoir yielding big trout but fishing only fair since lunkers stomachs are filled with minnows.  
 Ellery and Tioga lakes poor, Saddlebag Lake now very good. East Walker River good and West Walker fair to good, with big brown trout in both streams.

 John Tom Jones served as best man, and ushers were James Pearson and Ray Hargett.






