

PREVIEW OPENING

Meiji's Features Complete Line of Fish, Oriental Foods

Preview Opening of Meiji's market, which will specialize in a complete selection of strictly fresh fish as well as Oriental food products and foods, was announced for this week-end, starting today.

The market, which is located at Denker and Redondo Beach boulevard, starts its grand opening activities today, offering many specials, according to Proprietor Sus Yasuda. Other departments, in addition to the fish and meat department, include: produce, groceries, liquor, prescription and drugs (with a pharmacist on duty), and a lunch counter. Commenting on the fish department, Yasuda stated: "We offer both fresh water and ocean fish. If it swims, we've got it." The market is owned and operated by local people, Yasuda stated further. Prior to opening the new

store, Yasuda operated a fish market at LaSalle and Redondo Beach boulevard, which he opened in 1950. Yasuda lives with his family at 13801 South Halldale. During World War II he served as a language instructor with the War Department G-2 program in a civil service capacity. He has lived in the Los Angeles area since 1947. Prior to going into the market business, he was in the freezing, packing and exporting fish business. Before the war he operated a drug store in Stockton.
