

### Statewide Rabies Control Committee Calls Meeting

Since January 1955, a total of 291 cases of rabies have been reported in 26 counties of California from Tehama County to the Mexican border.

"This is of epidemic proportions, not reached since World War I," according to S. V. Christerson, Salinas, chairman of the newly organized Statewide Rabies Control Committee.

The committee, a subcommittee of the California State Chamber of Commerce's Statewide Agricultural committee, will hold its first meeting, Tuesday, October 18, in San Francisco, to discuss the possible need for legislation requiring compulsory vaccination of California dogs against rabies.

Serving on the committee will be a cross-section of technical experts, farmers, legislators, physicians, State and local health officers, veterinarians, housewives and representatives of private and State agencies.
