## Titans Trounce Saxons, Varsity Still Winless

San Marino's senior-studded griders knocked off the Saxon varsity 48-7 last Friday in a practice tilt on their gridiron.

The contest, third in the history of North High, was completely dominated by the Titans who outweighed the locals by about five pounds per man.

The seniors and a junior composed the starting lineup for San Marino, and this unit went 67 yards in six plays after North High had kicked off to start the game.

Titan footballers scored twice and converted both times before the Saxons broke into the scoring column. The Saxons lone came in the middle of the second quarter with the ball resting on their own 7 yard line; third down, and six yards to go. At this point Ray Grieshaber, fullback, faded to pass, and in doing so, stepped into the Saxon end zone.

Then with tacklers swarming around him like a group of hostile ants, Grieshaber threw 20 yards to end Jim Bald who was finally taken down on the Titan two yard line after a 61-yard romp.

The play was good for 81 yards and a first down. On the next play Grieshaber crashed through the Titan line and into the end zone for six points. Grieshaber again sliced through the Titan line and on this try picked up the extra

point. The halftime scoreboard read San Marino 20, North 7.

Although their offense seemed to click in the second half, the Saxons didn't score, however San Marino picked up four more touchdowns, and converted each time. This 28 point barrage in the final two stanzas hurt more than the hectic first half, and they never seemed the same.

**Tactics Used**  
The Titans employed varied phases of the "T" formation, while the Saxons used the "single wing. Aerial plays worked best for the Saxons, particularly the look-in and screen passes, which picked up yardage and an occasional first down, but failed, however to pay off in points.

So far San Marino is undefeated this year winning their first four games. In contrast North high hasn't won a game, losing to Artesia (13-20), El Cajon (6-24), and San Marino in their three practice encounters.

Friday the Saxons seek their first win when they take on Morningside at the Torrance high field in their first Pioneer League game.
