



EC 'Warhoop' Given All American Rating

All-American honors are held today by the El Camino college news publication, the Warhoop, Merl F. Sloan, award was made by the Associated College Press, with director of student personnel, announced today. The headquarters at the University of Minnesota.

The award covers papers published during the spring semester and is the fourth consecutive honor of its kind to be made to the campus weekly.

Seven junior colleges throughout the country were awarded the All-American rating by the ACP judges.

Newspaper classifications for judging are based upon total enrollment of the college which they represent and on frequency of publication. The Warhoop falls into the classification of a weekly published by a two-year college with an enrollment exceeding 5000.
