basis through direct loans from the state building fund to be paid back in from one to five years by districts that have voted bonds sufficiently in excess of legal capacity to sell to cover their emergency needs, Hull explained.

"The bond retirement schedule plus five per cent per level of 80 per cent of a five-year projection of assessed valuation trends, based on the past five years' experience in the district provide the basis of the proposed loan," Hull said.

He indicated that the County Council is studying it presently for a legal opinion.

Hull has already communicated with a number of individuals in key positions throughout the state. His plan has gained approval of the South Bay School Trustees association and the Torrance Board of Education.

#### Objectives

1. To put as much emergency school building aid as possible on a direct loan basis and reduce state participation.
2. To make emergency school aid the responsibility of the local district with encouragement of the State.
3. To reduce the number of years state funds would be tied up for those districts that can meet the formula.
4. To retain the advantages of local control.
5. To take advantage of the reduced costs that local control gives the school building program.
6. To reduce costs of state aid where a district can help itself.
7. To encourage each district with emergency building problems to finance the emergency on a short term basis if possible.
8. To reduce time required for school construction for emergency building where possible.
9. To get state money loaned to school districts back to the state as soon as possible.
10. To help overcome the lag between home and school construction.

#### Father's Club

In the light of this development and the recent national conference on education, members of the Fathers club in North Torrance who have been calling for action to reduce double sessions issued the following statement:

"The Fathers club feels that the Torrance school system is doing an excellent job considering the funds at hand and that when more funds are available we will have one of the best systems in the country.

"We feel that it will be unnecessary to continue our fight for this issue (eliminating double sessions)," Sam Freedman, chairman of the group concluded. "The best thing we can do is to resolve our differences and work for one goal. 'Ike' said: 'When sensible people get together, something sensible always comes out.' We concur."

Nicky is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Manuel Andrade of 1820 W. 245th st.




