## NTCIA Force In Success Of El Nido Annexation

The North Torrance Civic Improvement association has announced the reversal of the City Council's decision of two years ago pertaining to the annexation of the El Nido area to the City of Torrance.

At that time the vote went 4 to 1 against annexation, and proved to be a great disappointment to the El Nido residents. The N.T.C.I.A., after receiving a plea for assistance from the El Nido civic organization studied the proposal carefully and after due consideration decided the request was reasonable and the proposal beneficial to the City of Torrance. After writing a letter to the council, time for an informal hearing on the matter was granted with the official voting to be made later that evening when the council convened.

George Morehart, president, and Jack Kelly, annexation chairman of the El Nido civic spoke on the merits of the proposal, followed by John Kesson, president, and Edward Nobbe vice-president of the North Torrance Civic Improvement association, who spoke on pertinent but little considered facts pertaining to the annexation.

This time the voting was unanimous in favor of the proposal, with Mayor Isen and councilmen Drale, Schwab and Bensted voting aye, and councilman Blount absent.
