## PEST CONTROL MATERIALS LEGISLATION REGARDING

Recent legislation and additions have been made to the California Agricultural Code which are very important to every home owner and gardener in this area, and to avoid confusion with your nursery and garden supply dealer when you may wish to make certain purchases, I am listing these requirements.

Anyone using any of the pest control materials listed below is required to first obtain a permit from the County Agricultural Commissioner, 808 N. Spring st., Los Angeles 12 Calif. (Mutual 9211, Extension 2748). If you are going to use the material outside of the county it will be necessary for you to make the contract in the county.

Your dealer is required to have the buyer's signature upon a statement to the effect that he has the required permit be-

fore the material is delivered.

The following arsenic compounds in a form suitable for application as a dust where delivered in a quantity greater than 50 pounds in any 24 hour period: 1. Calcium arsenate, 2. Standard lead arsenate, and 3. Copper acetoarsenite (Paris Green).

The following organic phosphorus compounds in any amount: 1. TEPP, 2. Parathion, 3. Parathion (Metacide), 4. EPN, 5. OMPA (Schradan), and 6. Demeton (Systox).

## MUST REGISTER NOW TO SELECT PRESIDENT

County residents who want to help select a presidential candidate had better register now, County Supervisor Burton W. Chace warned today.

Chace, chairman of the Citizens Committee to "Get

Out the Vote," pointed out that the registration deadline for the June 5 consolidation primary is almost here.

"Those who don't register by midnight, April 12 will forfeit their right to vote in the primary," he said. "In our system of government by the majority, they will fail in their duty to help make the majority voice heard."

**Other Officers**

In addition to presidential and other federal candidates, there will be contenders for state and county offices. Primary voting for 31 state assemblymen, county district attorney, the county supervisors from the second, fourth and fifth districts and 48 municipal and superior court judges will take place.

The Citizens Committee to "Get Out the Vote," composed of 50 representatives from business, labor, government, the press and other community interests, is currently conducting a campaign to register all eligible voters.

Executive Coordinator Alfred A. Atherton says, "Out of an estimated county population of 5,473,000 only 2,011,445 voters registered as of January 3. This compares unfavorably with the registration mark of 2,510,000 for the last presidential election in 1952, when the county population was only about 4,400,000."

**Who Must Register**

According to Benjamin S. Hite, county registrar of voters, six classes of persons must register for the primary:

1. Those who have changed their address since they last registered.
2. Those who have changed their name since they last registered.
3. Those who desire to change their political affiliation.
4. Those who did not vote at either the primary or the general election 1954 and have not re-registered.
5. Those who will be 21 by June 5, and have not registered previously.
6. New residents who will have been in the county for 90 days and in the state for one year by June 5. Naturalized citizens must have been citizens for at least 90 days prior to June 5.

Residents who do not fall into one of the above classes need not re-register. Voters must be able to read English, must be able to sign their names and must have committed no felonies.

Hite, who has nearly 2,200 deputy registrars throughout the county, warns against late registration.

"Persons should register immediately to avoid the long lines which inevitably develop before registrars' desks the last two or three days," he advises.
