Eminent Health Authorities To Serve On Conference

Eminent authorities in the field of health will serve as panel and workshop experts at the Harbor Area's second Annual Community Health conference, according to Mrs. Miriam Fay Furlong, Harbor district supervisor of public health nurses for the

Los Angeles City Health department and head of the conference planning committee. The conference, an all-day session with registration beginning at 9 a.m., is set for Saturday, April 21, at Harbor junior college, 1111 Figueroa Street, Wilmington. The public is welcome, said Mrs. Furlong. Speakers at the luncheon symposium will be: Monsignor Patrick Roche, assistant superintendent of Catholic school for the Los Angeles Archdiocese; K. H. Sutherland, M.D., assistant health officer for the Los Angeles County Health department; and Earl D. Donaldson, D.D.S., president of the Harbor

District Dental society. Others will be: Robert G. Lehman, M.D., member of the board of the San Pedro Community hospital, and Mrs. Hazel Newman, immediate past-president of the Harbor Area Welfare planning council, a Community Chest service agency. Symposium subject will be "Responsibilities: Of the School Administrator and the Parent; Of Official and Voluntary Community Agencies; Of the Private Dentist; Of the Private Physician; and Of the Citizen" in meeting community health needs.

Workshop moderators will be: J. C. Rogers of the occupational health division of the Los Angeles City Health department; Miss Helen Stout, chief psychiatric social worker of the California State department of Social Hygiene; Max H. Schoen, D.B.S., of Wilmington; and Lillian Kozitza, M.D., director of maternal and child health for the City of Los Angeles.

Preceding 4 p.m. adjournment, Dr. Ralph Sachs, director of district services of the Los Angeles City Health department will summarize conference findings and present panel resolution to be adopted for future action.


