

Unit Leaders Ready For Cancer Drive

Observance Of Public Schools Week Slated

For the purpose of bringing all citizens of the community into closer working relationships with the public schools, the 37th annual observance of California Public Schools Week will be celebrated in the Los Angeles City School Districts April 23-27.

The program will feature such activities as open houses, pageants, and classroom visitations where parents and other citizens may learn more about the educational program and services of the schools.

Public Schools Week also provides an opportunity for all persons to observe the work of the public schools, develop a common understanding of the

schools, build an understanding of the problems and needs of the fast-growing Los Angeles City school system, develop appreciation of the many benefits of education, and honor the great contributions made by the public schools of this city and state.

In celebration of the week, all Los Angeles City Schools will feature exhibits of students' work and many thousands of teachers will meet with many thousands of parents to discuss mutual interests—children.

Although no over-all theme has been adopted for this year's observance of Public Schools Week, nearly 525,000 students

and 30,000 employees of the city public schools are expected to participate in the week-long program. Despite the fact that some schools already have held formal open house festivities, all schools will stand ready for visitations by the public.

Three objectives of Public Schools Week are: a better understanding of how schools teach fundamentals and citizenship, increased confidence by the public in the teaching profession, and the recognition of the need for more teachers.

"The fight against cancer must be everybody's business," the leaders agreed. "One of every four Americans now living will be stricken and that means more than 1,000,000 in our own County may be in peril. We must look squarely at the facts and personally take action," they stated.
