

## Armed Forces College Studies National Supply

For the fourth successive year high ranking members of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces visited the Torrance plant of the National Supply co. recently, as part of a scheduled familiarization program conducted by the Department of Defense.

This program, under direction of the joint Chiefs of Staff, is carried on the highest educational level within the department and is designed to prepare carefully selected officers of the Armed Forces for important positions in military service under industrial mobilization.

I. C. A. F. members include civilians as well as military personnel, in training for command, staff, procurement and logistic assignments.

It is through these scheduled plant visits that the members of the Industrial College class become familiar with manufacturing processes, developments, techniques and problems with which they could not otherwise become acquainted.

Eighteen members of the I. C. A. F. comprised the 1956 traveling group who climaxed their West Coast tour with

observation of the completely integrated manufacturing facilities of National Supply company.

National's works manager, J. D. Spalding, reviewed plant contributions to World War II and Korean conflict production requirements, with elaboration on status of the Torrance plant in an emergency industrial mobilization.

ROY BEATS CANCER

## 5-YEAR-OLD BOY WINS BOUTS AGAINST CANCER

Many people think of cancer as an old person's disease, yet little Roy Arredondo of 12104 Martin street, Torrance, who is not quite six years old, has had cancer and survived it.

Roy, son of Mr. and Mrs. Manuel Arredondo, was only eight months old when his disease, known as the nation's number two killer, struck him.

His parents had taken him to a doctor because little Roy had a cold and besides, they wanted to have him checked over. During the course of a physical examination the doctor found that something was wrong with the baby's left eye. X-rays revealed that a malignant tumor was growing there, and if not stopped, it would soon take the child's life.

Surgery was performed to remove the eye and afterwards the baby was examined by a doctor every week for a year, and then every two weeks.

Roy seemed to be progressing well until he was two years old. During one of his check-ups, his doctor discovered a new malignant growth in his other eye. This time X-ray treatments were given the baby

every weekday for two months. As he responded to the treatments, they were gradually reduced to twice a week, then they were given weekly, monthly, every three months, and finally every six months. The disease was caught in time, and the baby's life was saved again.

No Longer Worried

Now approaching six years, Roy still has regular checkups but his parents don't worry about him any more.

His aunt, Mrs. Dora Arredondo of 22121 So. Wilmington, Long Beach, who cares for him during the daytime along with her two youngsters, says that Roy has good vision in his right eye. He enjoys sports and all normal activities of a small boy, and likes to play with his brother Ronnie, 9, and sister Helen, 13.

Having followed him through both of his bouts with cancer, his aunt says, "It was very fortunate that the malignancies

were discovered so soon. Our family feels it is very important for parents to know the facts about this disease and to see that their children have regular physical examinations. We believe the American Cancer Society is helping a great deal to save lives of young and old alike by urging families to have periodic checkups." According to the Society, one of the little-known facts about the disease is the toll of children's lives it takes, killing more youngsters from 3 to 15 years than anything else except accidents.
