

*The Green Thumb*  
**Azalea Offers Color Variety  
 In Yard and Patio Gardens**

Those of you who visited the International Flower Show lately probably were thrilled at the beauty of the various types of azalea plants exhibited there. Needless to say it is not advisable to try to duplicate those massed conditions in your own yard.

A few azaleas sensibly used can, however, add interesting color to your garden. The color range is wide as is the shape of the flower and the size of the leaf.

Years ago we used to consider the azalea a shade loving plant and they will stand a great deal. But it is also surprising to many the amount of sun that they will take and how much

better some of them look when planted in almost full sun.

Two varieties that you might consider for full sun planting in this area are the Southern Indica and the Macrantha types.

Others can stand an Eastern exposure where there is sun during the morning but some shade during the hottest part of the day.

Another nice place where the azalea can be used is beneath a tree which gives filtered light. They also make excellent potted plants to brighten a porch or patio slab.

When azaleas are planted they should be set in almost pure

peat moss, with good drainage, and fertilized once a month with liquid fertilizer, March through October.

This plant food should be of an acid type. If you prefer to use a commercial or dry type plant food, space your feedings to March, June and September. This commercial food should

also have an acid reaction.

By carefully choosing your types and varieties it is possible to extend the bloom of these lovely plants from about October until Summer.

Your nurseryman can show you some interesting plants in full bloom at this time, and also will advise you as to the variety.


