A psychologist by profession, he has taught at Rutgers and New York universities. During World War II he was chief psychologist for Air Force in charge of testing and selecting all Negro pilots.

He was later recalled to service to do further psychological tests for the Air Force.

Kaufman, who arrived in Los Angeles in 1948, is now teaching at Los Angeles Harbor junior college.

In addition, Kaufman, his wife Natalie, and their four children, Gene, 14; Sue, 12; Betty, 3½; and Charles, 15 months; have an enterprising chicken ranch in North Redondo.
