B. C. Walker, of Walker-Murray, general engineering and building contractors for the swimming pool, felt that the pool would be ready "probably sometime at the last part of July around August 1."
Completion of the pool, he said, is dependent on delivery of materials. Still to be done are the painting, various plumbing and electrical installations, walks around the pool, and fencing of the pool.

Million Dollar Center
The new civic center, which is located at Madrona ave. on Torrance blvd., is the result of a \$950,000 bond issue approved by the voters two years ago.

The eventual cost will probably amount to around \$1,200,000, City Manager Stevens stated. The extra money has already been paid out of the city's general fund or will be provided in this year's budget.

The money in excess of the bond issue is needed for grading, furnishing, sewers, landscaping, and architectural fees. The bond money was put entirely into construction of the building and site acquisition, Stevens said.

The swimming pool will accommodate 644 individuals at one time. The bath house may also be used for various youth activities during the autumn and winter months.

Dedication ceremonies August 11-12 will include a water carnival, barbecue, and rodeo. The barbecue will be sponsored by the Civitan club. The rodeo is being sponsored jointly by the Torrance Mounted Police and Lions club. Tickets for the barbecue and rodeo are now being sold by members of the various groups.

and safety offices, or libraries. Licenses are also available at the main office of the County Pound, 11270 South Garfield avenue, Hondo, California. This office is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Dog owners who wish to mail their remittance may do so. Personal checks or money

orders will be accepted and should be made payable to the Los Angeles County Pound Department in the amount of \$3. All application requests must give the owner's full name, address, telephone number, and the description of the dog, and include a valid rabies vaccination certificate. As a convenience to the dog owners in this area, a deputy from the Pound Department will be on duty at the Lennox

Sheriff's station, 4331 Lennox boulevard each Saturday beginning July 7, through July 28, between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. A Los Angeles County dog license shall not be issued for any dog, unless the owner provides satisfactory proof that such dog is less than six months of age, or exhibit a valid vaccination certificate showing that

such dog has been vaccinated with rabies vaccine or that such dog should not be vaccinated with rabies vaccine because such vaccination would jeopardize the health of the dog due to age, infirmity or other disability. Los Angeles County dog license fees for the fiscal year 1956-57 will become due on July

1 for all dogs three months of age, or older, in the unincorporated area of the county.
