Lennox sheriff's deputies are this week looking for two men involved in a stabbing last Saturday night at a Lomita bar. One man, Douglas B. Clair, 21, 1010 West 256th street, Harbor City, is being detained for his part in the fray, the sheriff's office reported.

Doke, 26, 1533 Pier avenue, Redondo Beach, the bartender, was treated for slashes about the neck administered during the brawl which took place on the sidewalk in front of the bar, the deputies said.
