A new Walteria park of approximately 13 acres near Newton st. on Madison ave. also was recommended in addition to the 55 acres previously recommended for addition to the civic center site.

Two additional park sites were suggested by the North Torrance Civic Improvement association. They are: five acres at 182nd st. and Crenshaw blvd. and five acres on Gramercy near 166th streets.
