Temple Menorah To Hold High Holiday Services

Jews throughout the world will observe their High Holy Days—Rosh Hashanah, The Jewish New Year and Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement—beginning at sunset, Wednesday, September 5.

Temple Menorah, located at 112½ North Catalina, Redondo Beach, has obtained Dr. Rabbi Phillip Rosenberg to officiate at their High Holy Day Services. He will be assisted by Cantor Nat Pickus. The first evening's services will begin at 7:30 p.m.

The Holy Days area 10-day span devoted to religious self-examination. They reach their climax with Yom Kippur, Saturday, September 15, when most of the day is spent in the synagogue offering prayers which ask for divine forgiveness for faults and weaknesses. Many fast on Yom Kippur. The services are concluded with the blowing of a ram's horn—a note of triumph and spiritual liberty.

President Ben Kaufman announces that there will also be a special children service on Saturday, September 15, 2:30 p.m., which will be participated in by children from the Temple Menorah Religious School.
