

Pastor Back From 7-Day Convention

Pastor Glenn L. Goffar and his family of Torrance Seventh-day Adventist church are returning to their home at 4527 Palos Verdes drive, north, following a five day major church conference in the San Bernarino mountains.

During this week Pastor Goffar and his wife have been attending lectures, discussion

groups and panel sessions on major church plans and problems of Southern California ministers. More than 250 other clergymen from Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and Ventura counties have been attending the convention.

In addition to hearing outstanding Southland church ministers present addresses at the

conference, Pastor Goffar has heard lectures by noted international authorities on counseling and archaeology. Dr. Seigfried Horn, Washington, D.C., presented daily studies on ways in which archaeology has proven Biblical teachings. Dr. G. T. Anderson, president of the College of Medical Evangelists, Dr. W. F. Specht, director of the

School of Religion, La Sierra College, Arlington, California; and Dr. Arthur L. Bietz, director, Division of Religion, College of Medical Evangelists, were other major speakers of the conference.

Other sessions of the meet, were devoted to a discussion of ways in which ministers' wives could aid their husbands in their pastoral work. Mrs. Ione Goffar, wife of the local Adventist pastor, attended these sessions.


