



Madison street and north of the present airport property could be acquired later for an access road.

In the second phase, top priorities would go to the construction of a new runway and the extension of the existing one. Also involved is the removal of all buildings encroaching on the restricted zone and the construction of a new connector street on the north side of the airport.

Recommended for immediate purchase are the 36-acre site west of the airport and the 49-acre site in the Walteria lake area. Purchase of the 40-acre site on the northern boundary is recommended in the future.

New Hours Announced For Pool

Beginning today, Thursday, September 13, the Torrance Municipal Plunge will remain closed during the week days and evenings. The pool will remain open the usual hours on Saturdays and Sundays until Sunday, October 28, which is tentatively set as the closing date for the pool.

Saturday and Sunday schedules will be: Saturday, 10 a.m. to 12 noon, and 1 to 5:30 p.m.; Sunday, 12 noon to 6 p.m. The reason for the change in the schedule was announced by Cliff Graybehl, pool manager, as being the close of the summer vacation and the beginning of the fall school term. Any further changes involving the pool schedules will be announced in this newspaper at a later date.

date of the election. These qualifications are:

a. One year's residence in the State.

b. Ninety days' residence in the county.

c. Twenty-one years of age.

d. A naturalized citizen must have been a citizen for at least 90 days prior to the date of election and must show his naturalization papers to the deputy when registering for the first time.

e. All voters must be able to read English and sign his name and must not be disqualified to vote by reason of a felony conviction.

Individuals may register at the Torrance city hall, located on Torrance boulevard at Maple (between Crenshaw and Hawthorne) or they may call the city clerk's office (FA. 8-5310) for the address of their nearest registrar of voters.


