Parents of physically handicapped children, residing in Torrance, will be interested to know that educational facilities are now available for almost any type of physical disability that requires special educational consideration. Last year Torrance Unified Schools joined the Southwest Schools Cooperative Special Education program, a joint venture participated in by seven separate school districts. This program provides special opportunity to educable physically handicapped children who can

Blind, kindergarten through 8th grade; partially seeing, first through 8th grade; blind and partially seeing, 9th through 12th grade; deaf and severely hard of hearing, 3 years through 8th grade; deaf and severely hard of hearing, 9th through 12th grade; orthopedic—delicate, 1st through 8th grade; cerebral palsy, 9th through 12th grade.


