

Plant two presently has assembly lines for a metal structure which enables the B-50 bomber to be converted to the KB-50, the Boeing ribs which are used on the KC-135 (the commercial counterpart being the 707), the Navy gun shield which is a metal shield for the Navy's three inch 50 caliber gun and the Webcor Pod. They also have scheduled work for Convair, H. I. Thompson, Rohr Aircraft and the Navy.

Plant two, located near the Torrance airport, covers 56,000 sq. ft., manufacturing area covers 45,000 sq. ft. and offices the remaining 11,000 sq. ft. Plans are underway to add an addition to be used for material storage.
