City Acts To Correct Bad Drainage

Drainage problems in the Victoria Terrace area have been given a priority listing as a result of a picture appearing in the Torrance Press last week.

Homeowners in the 22900 block of Evalyn street complained that the city had promised to correct drainage conditions, remove a temporary fence, and reinforce the

permanent fence by spring of this year.

So far, there had been no action. Homeowners were worried as to what would happen in case of another rainy season.

The city manager's office indicated this week that a plan for action was initiated after a visit to the area by the city manager, engineer, and street superintendent.

One of the sumps will be drained first; then it will be left to dry and then scraped so the water can drain properly; the pipe will be reinforced with concrete (broken concrete, like a sea-wall) to prevent the water from backing up and undercutting the embankment; and a retaining wall will be placed under the fence.

The city manager's office indicated that work has started on the sump.


