MURDER HEARING FRIDAY

Preliminary hearing for Fred E. Horsley, 36, was set for Friday, November 2, in the South Bay Municipal Court.

Horsley is accused of slaying his wife, Maudie Lee Horsley, 34, October 16 in the kitchen of their home, 3221 W. 190th st.

Judge Otto B. Willett, before Horsley was arraigned, ordered Horsley held without bail.

Counsel for Horsley indicated that he will enter a plea of innocent and ask for jury trial if his client is ordered to stand trial in Superior Court.

Horsley has steadfastly maintained that his wife was killed by an intruder.
