School District Makes Survey Of Handicapped

The schools of the Torrance Unified School District are currently conducting a survey of kindergarten age children with Orthopedic or Delicate conditions.

This would include such physical handicaps as: birth injury (Erb's palsy, bone fractures, etc.), joint tuberculosis, osteomyelitis, congenital amputation, clubfoot, spina bifida, bone tumors, bone cysts, fragile bones, muscular dystrophy, and any other conditions that would require special classes and special transportation.

At the present time, children with these handicaps are admitted to special classes at the first grade level. This survey of kindergarten age children is being made to determine whether it is feasible to provide a kindergarten program for these children. The survey would be concerned with children born on or before December 2, 1951.
