

4 Architects Begin Plans For Hospital

Four architects have been appointed to prepare plans for construction of the new buildings at Harbor General hospital. The appointments were approved Tuesday, November 13, by the County Board of Supervisors.

Named were Francis Heusel, Long Beach, Welton Beckett, Adrian Wilson and Paul Williams of Los Angeles. They will work with local hospital authorities and the County Department of Charities

to draw up the plans for the project which will be financed by the \$15.4 million bond issue passed at the November 6 election.

Construction may begin next year, according to county officials. The units will replace World War II structures now being used.
