**MVD WILL MOVE TO NEW SITE**

Complete drivers licensing and vehicle registration services with the Department of Motor Vehicles will become available to motorists of the Torrance area effective Monday, December 3 in a new field office located at 1907 Border ave.

Paul Mason, director of Motor Vehicles, in announcing the opening of the new office, said, "The State recognizes that the population growth in the Torrance area has brought about an increase in the need for Motor Vehicle Department services."

The Motor Vehicle director has invited State and local officials, Chamber of Commerce representatives, business and industry leaders and interested members of the motoring public to attend an informal opening ceremony at the new office to be held at 4 p.m., Friday, November 29.

Carlos S. Caldwell, manager

of the local office since May 1 of this year, said that the original opening of the Torrance office was January 25, 1954. At that time the office consisted of four employees and has grown to a present employment of 15. The operation of the office results in 250 registrations daily and 130 drivers license applications processed, Caldwell stated.

The brick and wood structure, constructed to State specifications, contains 3000 sq. ft. of office space. There are 17,000 sq. ft. parking space adjoining. Facility has been leased to the State for five years by Mr. and Mrs. Cornelius S. Connor of Torrance with five year renewal option.

The Torrance Chamber of Commerce is in charge of coordinating opening ceremonies featuring Gaye Wilson, "Miss Torrance" and State Assemblyman Vincent Thomas who was instrumental in the improvement.




