Harbor Area 4th In Chest Fund Drive

"Harbor Area stands in fourth place in the Associated Cities current Los Angeles Area Community Chest appeal to raise its \$10 million goal for the 168 participating Red Feather health, welfare and service agencies," Arthur O. Otsea, harbor area campaign chairman, said today.

"Goal for the harbor area is \$84,961, with \$58,822.23 or 69.23 per cent of quota raised to date," Otsea continued.

Harbor City-Lomita, setting the pace to meet 100 per cent of its \$2,411 goal, has reached \$2,210.30 or 91.67 per cent of quota. Rolling Hills, in second place, with a residential goal of \$5,117 has solicited \$3,981.03 or 77.80 per cent of its goal.

Placing third, Wilmington with a \$14,183 quota has raised \$11,024 or 77.72 per cent of goal; Torrance, fourth, with 76.77 per cent of its \$18,116 quota has raised \$13,908.94; San Pedro, fifth, with a goal of \$20,847 has solicited \$14,734.97 or 70.68 per cent of its quota.

With a goal of \$8,375 for the Palos Verdes school and residential areas, 65.81 per cent or \$5,512.37 has been solicited, placing the city in sixth place, with Gardena in last place with \$7,450.45 or 47.66 per cent of its \$15,632 quota solicited to date.

Hundreds of volunteer workers in the Associated Cities, of which Harbor Area is a part, and includes Southeast, San Fernando Valley, Centinela Valley and West Areas, has raised \$518,359 or 73.80 per cent of its \$702,360 goal.

Volunteer workers are currently conducting a "Victory Lift," a "mop-up" campaign to complete their assignments and call-backs in an effort to put the individual areas "over the top" in the Chest appeal.


