Industrial Development Reception Slated Today

Representing leaders in almost all phases of Los Angeles county's business activity will be 500 industrialists and executives who have been invited to attend a pre-opening ceremony and a reception today marking the near completion of Susana road in the Rancho San Pedro industrial development. The group will be the guests of the Del Amo, Carson and Dominguez Estates companies.

When ready for use, Susana road will serve as one of the key thoroughfares within the industrial development which is rated as an ideally planned project.

After talks to be made by prominent business figures at the site at 2 p.m., the assemblage will be entertained at the Virginia Country club in Long Beach from 3 to 5 p.m.

Approximately 1500 acres are contained in the Rancho San Pedro industrial area which is located south of Compton. Fire Station Dedication Slated Sat.


