



**Constructed At Longren**

Hampden Wentworth, president and chairman of the Board of Longren Aircraft company, announced today that his company has begun construction on a new 20,500 sq. ft. warehouse building behind their new plant on Crenshaw boulevard at the Torrance Airport.

The new warehouse building will be used for raw material storage and will also house an Alodine and Scotch-Prime processing installation. Longren's new 56,000 sq. ft. general office and assembly plant was completed last July at 24751 Crenshaw boulevard.

Longren presently has two plants—one at the Crenshaw location and one at 2576 West Carson street, Torrance, which is a fabrication plant. The new warehouse building boosts the total office and manufacturing area for the company to 123,000 sq. ft.

Receipt of a large contract from Convair, San Diego for Interspar Rib Assemblies for the supersonic F-102A interceptor and an additional large contract from Boeing, Seattle, for Interspar Rib Assemblies for Boeing's KC-135 jet tanker and the 707 commercial jet airliner, has necessitated the additional floor space.



**TRANSFER OF OFFICE**



**Firm Locates In Torrance**

Horkey Associates, Los Angeles engineering firm, has moved into a 5000 sq. ft. wing at Longren Aircraft corporation's Torrance plant, 24751 S. Crenshaw, in the company's first general expansion program since its organization less than a year ago. President Edward J. Horkey has announced.

**10 Different Mira Costa Home Exteriors Available**

Half of the homes in Mira Costa Terrace, a \$2 million harbor view homes development, have already been sold, officials of the firm indicated this week.

The fine quality homes, situated on the slopes of Palos Verdes overlooking the harbor, are being offered in the \$17,000 to \$18,000 price range.

Ten different exteriors and five floor plans are being featured in these homes built by the Mira Costa Construction co. The dwellings may be found on varying levels, many with panoramic views. Mira Costa Terrace is the third unit of residences completed since the company started building on the east slope of Palos Verdes hills.

It is located one mile north of Peck park in San Pedro off Western ave., or three miles south of Pacific Coast highway off Western ave.

Homes are available to qualified veterans with a five per cent down payment. Houses are also available through FHA and conventional financing.

Dwellings range from provincial and ranch style to contemporary and modern. Homes feature nu-tone built-in mixer blenders, built-in Western Holly ovens and ranges, nu-tone hood and exhaust wood burning fireplace; natural finish ash cabinets, garbage disposal, ceramic tile throughout, rock wool insulation, thermo-controlled forced air heat, general lath and plaster, one and three-quarter baths colored fixtures, outdoor living, sliding horizon glass doors, aluminum sliding windows, weatherstrip exterior doors, two-car oversized garage, lawn and shrubs, and concrete driveways, among others.

**Torrance Teachers Granted Pay Increase**

Teachers have been granted an increase in salary as a result of action taken by the School Board of the Torrance Unified School district Monday.

The board granted one increase which will go into effect January 28 and at the same time established the salary schedule for the 1957-1958 school year. As of January 28 beginning teachers with a regular credential will start with a salary of \$4305. Top salary after 14 years and the equivalent of a PhD will be \$7089, according to officials.

The present salary equivalent is \$4100-\$6780. The increase amounts to about 5 per cent, it was stated. As of September 1, 1957, salaries will go up to a minimum of \$4500 and maximum of \$7700.

Officials said that the present increase places Torrance in a favorable position with the better paying cities in Southern California with whom the local district must compete.


**Step Taken For Sewer Service**

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced this week that the board of supervisors has taken the first step necessary to provide sanitary sewer service to residents living in the area between 182nd and Electric streets between Normandia and Vermont avenues.

Following receipt of a petition signed by the majority of property owners of the area, the board instituted special assessment proceedings and directed the county engineer to prepare the resolution of intention for the project under the 1913 municipal improvement act. Supervisor Hahn said that present plans call for the sewers to be installed in the east-west alley between Electric and 182nd.
