**Lot Of Noise About Noise At Meeting**


Residents near Longren Aircraft, 2567 Carson st., reluctantly agreed to another meeting with Longren officials to discuss noisy and annoying conditions, hoping that the company might do something about them this time. This decision was reached at a meeting of the Planning Commission last week. Appearing there on behalf of his firm was President Hampton Wentworth who suggested a joint meeting of residents and company officials. Homeowners at first indicated that they did not want any more of what they considered do-nothing meetings but finally agreed to try once more at the request of the Planning Commission. Commissioner Dave Figuero, who said he lives two blocks from the Longren plant, stated that he could hear the noise from the plant all night long. Employee parking in residential areas also came in for criticism. Wentworth reportedly indicated that customers and salesmen are frequently careless about they way they park. He indicated that he was very strict with his own employees regarding this matter. Wentworth replied to a charge that employees leave refuse and litter around the streets by saying that he has a full-time maintenance man whose sole job is to patrol the premises. He said he would talk to him. The investigation of conditions was requested several weeks ago by Commissioners Bill King and Dave Figuero.


