This Year Give Myrrh Frankincense at Christmas

The mystic symbolism of the ancients was represented in the gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh that the Magi brought to the Infant Jesus.

Frankincense had for centuries been used by both the Egyptians and the Jews in religious rituals, and curative powers attributed to it for the treatment of an astonishing variety of ailments.

Myrrh held a similar role of importance and was highly esteemed as an ointment and perfume, a ceremonial incense and an ingredient of embalming oils. So highly treasured were these fragrant resins that pots and vases of ivory and alabaster were fashioned to preserve them.

Historians tell us that frankincense was burned to purify the air, and that to breathe the fragrance would "comfort and refresh the spirit"—much as smelling salts are used today. A potion of frankincense was believed to be an antidote for

hemlock poisoning, as well as a cure for leprosy.

Myrrh was the main ingredient of the anointing oil of the Tabernacle. Kings and queens used it to perfume and beautify themselves.

Mixed with water or wine and taken internally, it was believed to be at once a stimulant and sedative, a tonic and astringent.

Today many resins are referred to as myrrh, but "true" myrrh was a gum resin, product of the Commiphora Myrrah, a small tree that grows in East Africa and Arabia.

Frankincense is a product of a tree of the Boswellia family, and native of the same areas.

BANK MONEY ORDERS—CASHIER CHECKS—DRAFTS—TRAVELERS CHEQUES

Bank money orders offer a simple and convenient means for payment of bills if a checking account is not maintained or if other than a personal check is a requirement. These money orders are sold through our Savings window number 2, and can be issued in a matter of seconds. The type of check used permits the customer to sign the money order purchased, and it is protected against alterations by a modern protectograph machine. These money orders are issued up to \$200.00 and the cost is only 15c per check. Compare this charge with postal money orders and you will soon be convinced that purchase of bank money orders is a definite savings to you.

Our cashier checks are drawn against funds deposited by the purchaser and are signed by an officer of the bank. These checks can be issued without imposing a limit on the amount for which drawn and for that reason provide a convenient method of transferring larger sums of money from one individual to another or from one city to any point in the United States. The cost for the average check is only 25c.

Drafts are also used for transfer of money and payment of bills and differ from Cashier Checks only to the extent of being drawn on a bank in another city in which our bank carries an account. The cost of these drafts is also nominal and is based upon the amount of money represented.

We invite you to come to the bank and avail yourself of this convenient and safe means of paying bills or transferring money to other persons or business establishments. Keep in mind that money orders, cashier checks, and drafts, are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation the same as a bank deposit, up to \$10,000.00 for each depositor. Travelers cheques offer a safe means of carrying money while on a trip and are issued at a cost of \$1.00 per \$100.00. These are available in various denominations and are honored nationally as well as in other countries. If you are planning a trip, make a trip to our bank first to fortify yourself with these cheques and you will enjoy worry-free vacation or travel.
