

Assemblyman Vincent Thomas and Mrs. Thomas were guests of the board of directors of the Lomita Civic League December 20.

They were entertained at the Trefethen home, 2432 Chapman avenue, which was established in 1920. In 1929 the legal battle which kept Lomita smog-free centered around the Trefethen acres when an attempt was made to install a smoky industry on adjoining property.

Following a court victory for the Trefethens, the first attempt was made to incorporate Lomita. This attempt failed.

Assemblyman Thomas was able to give the group the benefit of his long experience in the legislature and his knowledge of legislation in regard to incorporations and annexations, viewed against a background of the organized forces attempting to bring about such changes.

Mrs. Hazel Fay, membership chairman of the Lomita Civic League, was a classmate of Thomas' in San Pedro high school, and members of the Trefethen family were also in the student body.
