have indicated that Torrance's move will only cause redoubled effort on Lomita's part to incorporate.

While Torrance filed its intention a week ago Wednesday, it refiled again Friday for Rolling Hills and Monday for Lomita as a matter of technicality, since those dates marked the expiration dates for the incorporation filings.

Lomita incorporation forces, however, refiled again Monday, also.

The Lomita annexation would include all of Lomita bounded on the south by Palos Verdes Dr. N., on the east by the city of Los Angeles, on the north and west by Torrance.

The Rolling Hills territory is bounded by Rolling Hills rd., Palos Verdes Dr. N., Torrance, and an irregular piece of land east of Narbonne ave.

Before the territory can be annexed, a majority of the voters will have to approve the proposal in a special election.

Amused, Bothered, And Bewildered

I was thoroughly amused, and somewhat bewildered, at Torrance's present bid to annex portions of the Palos Verdes Hills and most of Lomita.

After the "cold war" 18 months ago when that city was asked by the Great Lakes Carbon corporation to annex 9,000 acres of uninhabited area and the plan met with such furor from adjacent residents, it seems implausible that the Torrance city fathers would want to pour fuel onto a still-smoldering fire.

The city of Torrance cannot offer this a anything but "local" administration, and I cannot feel that this is more important than providing good every day municipal services, which we now have.

The county fire department has three fire stations within three miles of here and offers excellent service at a reasonable tax rate. Our insurance premiums reflect this.

The sheriff's office assigned an additional car in this area a month ago, and their service has improved greatly. In addition, it is nice to know that when a sheriff's unit comes into the area, it is manned by qualified officers who have been trained at a police academy. I understand that Torrance PD relies strictly on an "on the job training" policy from the day a man starts on the force. Some Torrance cars, it seems, are manned by officers who are first day on the job.

Your health department, Torrance, is the same as ours; you contract to the county health department.

Our road department is tops. Just drive down your own Arlington Ave., city fathers, and when the pavement gets good, you know you are on Narbonne Avenue in county area. Also, have you ever driven down Rolling Hills Road near Pacific Coast Hwy? And, how about those faded white lines on Torrance streets?

Our building and safety department has not been involved in a scandal in decades. How about yours, Torrance?

We are not paying off bonds for a new lavish city hall, police station and big swimming pool, which hardly would benefit us mile away here.

Thanks, Torrance, but we just like the "county" way of life.
