**Fluoridation...**

on to say, fluoridation may reduce the decay rate up to 30 per cent.  
As of October 1, 1955, there were 1115 cities fluoridating their water involving 30 million people.  
Fluoridating water one part per million does not involve any

kind of danger, the dentist went on to say, indicating that there are 400 cities having natural fluoridation, often in excess of 1 ppm.  
Among those endorsing fluoridation are the American Dental Assn., American Medical Assn., US Public Health, and National Research Council.  
The Army Medical service is introducing fluoridation at all its installations.  
PTA Favors It  
Mrs. Dorothy Stoeckle spoke next, indicating that the Na-

tional and California Congress of PTAs both approve fluoridation and that Torrance's 20 PTAs are vitally interested in the issue.  
Money, she said, is not an issue when the health and welfare of children are concerned.  
Hitchcock then concluded by saying that the cost of fluoridation is insignificant when balanced against the annual dental bills of the families involved.  
Opponents of the measure spoke next.  
Fred Smith simply warned

the council of the political decision which can arise over such an issue.  
Stating that he lived in Rio Vista (near Sacramento), he gave the audience an idea of what to expect if fluoridation is approved by the council.  
Rio Vista, which took similar action, became a political battleground, and fluoridation was constantly dragged out into the arena and fought over irrationally.  
John W. Henderson, representative of the Los Angeles

County Department of Engineering, said his office has asked him to register opposition on grounds that not enough is known of the personal tolerance of individuals to fluoridation.  
Mrs. M. L. Livingston opposed fluoridation because it "violates our country's Bill of Rights." Dental health, she said, is a private not a public affair.  
She charges that fluorides are poisonous.  
Mrs. Beth Malan quoted from a report of the University of

the State of New York seeking to show that the Newburgh-Kingston experiment was not successful. She called fluoridation a "vicious murder program... and morally wrong."  
She also cited Provo, Utah, case where cattle are said to have suffered ill effects from fluoridated water.  
Robert Schneider also cited the University of the State of New York report which seeks to discredit the Kingston-Newburgh experiment.

**Cost Prohibitive**

He also indicated that fluoridation costs would be closer to \$225,000. He said there is a difference between natural fluorides and artificial fluorides and that they act differently.  
Angus McVicar, Torrance water superintendent, opposed fluoridation. McVicar said Torrance water now has about three-tenths of one part per million fluorides and that metropolitan water, which is used here mostly, had up to five-tenths of one part per million in 1949.  
Besides, there are five different water systems serving the area.  
While an exact cost estimate was difficult, McVicar figured the installation would cost about \$60,000 and supervision and material \$10,000.  
He said, too, that there is a difference between chlorine and fluoride—chlorine can be boiled out of water but fluorine cannot be removed.  
He figured the cost to the whole city would be closer to \$200,000 than \$60,000.

**Waste**

Of the 25 million gallons of water used on peak days, he went on to say, only a slight amount—10,000 gallons—is used for drinking purposes.  
Councilmen next asked questions and proponents had a chance for rebuttal. Other points brought out were that children from eight months before birth to 12 years old benefit from fluoridation; anything less than 1 ppm is of no value.
