'Famous Lost Words' Clever Champion of English Grammar

English grammar is being stressed dramatically at Casimir Elementary school—in every sense of the word.

Vernon Clary, eighth grade teacher, has made grammar "come to life" in a act play, "Famous Lost Words," to the delight and edification of his school audience.

The play, an old-fashioned "mellerdramer," revolves around a character, King Sam the Sentence Maker, and his Princess Adjective, who has been kidnapped by Shylock Wordjammer.

The case is finally solved by Shamrock Bones with the aid of the Duke of Speech, Murdock, Dr. John Wordsor, Count Verb, Count Noun, Count Preposition, Countess Adverb, Countess Pronoun, Countess Conjunction, and Countess Interjection.

Each character adds clues to the whereabouts of Princess Adjective.

The play sparkles with clever dialogue which teaches and delights, making its grammatical points systematically, without ever being dull or boring.

Dialogue includes such lines as the following:
VERB: . . . But I SAW who did take her. We all did.
KING: Pray tell, WHO, WHO, WHO?
ALL: SHYLOCK WORD-JAMMER.
SHAMROCK: Yes. I have heard of him. He is very shrewd, very clever. But no match for SHAMROCK BONES.
ADVERB: He is bigger than you!
SHAMROCK: I have BRAINS.
ADVERB: He is stronger than you.
SHAMROCK I have brains.
ADVERB: He has a gun.
SHAMROCK: So he blows my brains out.
SHAMROCK: How now, Noun, which way did they go??
NOUN: They left through the DOOR.
Across the MOAT;
In a tiny BOAT;
To the other SHORE.
They went up the ROAD.

3 LECTURERS TO BEGIN SERIES AT EL CAMINO

Three well-known lecturers—Dr. J. Michael Hagopian, Dr. Ashley Montagu, and Dr. Ralph E. Lapp—will headline the El Camino college lecture series starting February 13.

Dr. Hagopian, travel-lecturer and producer of motion pictures, will present his latest film-lecture, "Incredible India" in the ECC Campus Theater as the initial presentation.

A graduate of the University of California at Berkeley, Dr. Hagopian has filmed "Desert Destiny," "Himalayan Holiday," and "Pathways through Pakistan," all interpretative studies of Asia.

Highlighting the March series, Dr. Montagu, anthropologist, and author, has lectured mostly on one topic—the fairer sex.

"The Natural Superiority of Women" one of Montagu's books, was on the best seller list in 1953. A year earlier his article on the same subject was published in the "Saturday Review of Literature."

Montagu, a graduate of the University of London, has been professor of anatomy for the past 20 years at New York University and at the Hahnemann Medical college and Hospital in Philadelphia.


