LUTHERAN MINISTER ARRIVES HERE

Plans for the establishment of a new congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran church in West Torrance have been announced, with the arrival of the Rev. Gerald W. Garlid.

This congregation, which will be known as the Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd, is one of 39 new churches authorized during 1956 under the Home Mission program of the Evangelical Lutheran church, a member synod of the National Lutheran council, with headquarters in Minneapolis, Minn.



The initial day of worship and Sunday School is scheduled Sunday March 24. Arrangements are being made for a temporary place of worship for the new congregation, which will serve west Torrance and Redondo Beach. A site for the church structure will be purchased by funds made available by the Department of Home Missions of the E.L.C.

In preparation for the establishment of the Church a house-to-house survey and visitation program are now being conducted in the area by parish workers provided under the ELC Home Mission program.

This will be the third congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church to be established in the area. Other member congregations are on Palos Verdes Blvd. and in North Torrance.

Garlid came to Torrance from Chippewa Falls, Wis., where he served as pastor of Central Lutheran church for six years. Earlier he served in Minnesota at Heron Lake, Ellendale, and Appleton. A native of Cooperstown, N. Dakota, he is a graduate of North Dakota State college, Fargo, and Luther Theological seminary, St. Paul, Minn.

A parsonage has been purchased at 22924 Carlow road, for Mr. and Mrs. Garlid and their two sons, Kael, 12, and Peter 7.
