

Soprano, Youth Band To Perform

Adele Gebr, coloratura soprano, will be the featured soloist in the third in a series of Artist Concerts sponsored by the Torrance Area Youth band. Artist Concerts Sunday, March 9, at the Redondo Union High School auditorium. The Youth Band will play during the first half of the concert.

Miss Gebr is a comparatively newcomer to the American stage, having recently moved here from Europe and South America. She received most of her training in the leading opera companies of those countries.

Her program will include arias and selections by Mozart, Britten, Oubradors, Schubert, Paladilhe, Musorgsky, de Falla, Rossini, and Hageman. She will be accompanied at the piano by Raymond McFeeters.

Selections by the Youth Band will include "Aguero," "Paso Doble," the "Die Fledermaus" overture, "Finlandia," "Bathsheba," and "Cowboy Rhapsody." Soloists will be Mae Denton, violin; Jimmie Butterfield, bassoon, and Dale Reubart, piano.

Admission to these concerts are by season ticket, however, some seats will be available at the box office. The concerts begin promptly at 8 p.m.
