YMCA Raises \$18,700 \$2280 Short of Goal

The Torrance YMCA entered the home stretch in its 1957 fund drive this week, with \$18,700 raised thus far. This makes 89 per cent of their \$21,000 goal, or exactly \$2280 short.

At the annual YMCA dinner, Sam Levy, campaign chairman, stated that Torrance will make its goal. He said that if the goal is reached, the Torrance YMCA will be able to hire a second full-time staff member. By so doing, more than twice as many boys can be served by the local organization during 1957 as were served in 1956.

Youth Worker Needed
Levy again made an appeal to all citizens to share in the final efforts to reach the goal, and thus provide camps, leagues, clubs, worship, and education for 4500 boys.

Levy said that if the goal is not reached within 12 days the Torrance YMCA will lose an opportunity to hire an excellent youth worker who is specially trained to work with grade school boys and with high

school groups. Contributions should be mailed directly to the YMCA at 2080 Washington ave., or can be sent to Levy at his place of business.


Levy congratulated the 250 volunteer workers who have done so well on the YMCA drive this year, and handed out YMCA "Oswald" awards to all campaign division chairmen, singling out Sam Van Wagner for the 300 per cent of the goal drive raised by his Parents Division. Also C. C. Morgan was commended for the important part that industry played in the support of the Torrance "Y" for the year.

WHAT'S DOING

R. S. Pyle, your Telephone Manager in Torrance



NERVE CENTER for 12,000 telephones in the Torrance exchange is Pacific Telephone's central office at 1307 Cravens. Maintaining afternoon vigilance on vast communications network is switchman J. E. Mize. Majority of trouble cases spotted at test center consist of a telephone off hook or the dialing of a number incorrectly. Average time needed to repair a phone after first report of failure — 45 minutes.



R-O-H: That's what telephone line testers call it when they run into the situation like the one at the left. It means "receiver off the hook." A receiver hasn't been replaced quite right or it's accidentally propped up by some object. Whatever the cause, the plungers don't go all the way down and your line is as "busy" as if you were talking. It can cause you to miss calls. Watch out for R-O-H.
