


First Plastics Technical Service Laboratory In California Opens Here



FIRST IN CALIFORNIA

A major plastics manufacturer established California's first plastics technical service and development center today and paid tribute to "the tremendous swift growth" of the West Coast plastics industry.

The center—at Torrance—represents recognition by the Dow Chemical Co., of Pacific Coast contributions to the plastics industry.

It also represents a milestone for Dow in the growth of an idea which sprang to life in 1943 when the company established the first plastics technical service facility in the world at its headquarters plant in Midland, Michigan.

"The West Coast has done a wonderful job of raising a dynamic industry rapidly," said C. B. Branch, Dow plastics manager.

"There is a big industry here now, and it is going to be bigger."

Equipment and Services He said the new facilities will be staffed by skilled technical personnel to provide a variety of equipment and services for plastics users interested in "working together" to make better plastics products.

Louis E. Tallman, who has been handling plastics technical service work for Dow on the West Coast since 1950, will head the expanded California operation.

Tallman, a chemical engineer, has been active as an official of the Society of Plastics Engineers, Southern California section, and is a past vice president of Toastmasters International in Los Angeles.

The West Coast facility is adjacent to the Dow plant at Torrance which produces Styron (Dow polystyrene) and Styrofoam, two of the nation's most widely used plastic materials.

Reasons for Importance Branch said Dow considers the facility of major importance for several reasons:

The regional laboratory will be geared to local needs and can provide on-the-spot service to plastics fabricators. Its establishment parallels a trend to decentralize production facilities and fits product improvement objectives of direct interest to the West Coast.

With the addition of the new Torrance facility, Dow PTS groups now serve the country's four basic geographical areas. In addition to Midland, there are laboratories, men and equipment at Freeport, Texas, and at Allyn's Point, Connecticut.

Dr. William C. Goggin, plastics technical service manager, said the regional facilities provide an interplay of experience through central supervision in Midland, thus accelerating total industry advancement.

Technicians, trained by Dow, travel tens of thousands of miles each year and spend up to a third of their time in the plants of plastics fabricators.

Then they return to Dow laboratories to work with research, production and sales in industry's problems.

Variety of Projects Dr. Goggin said the work involves "rather an amazing variety" with plastics fabricators and users, large and small. "One fabricator may want us to help design new facilities or a new plastic mold, a fan blade or refrigerator part, for instance."

"Another might want advice on use of equipment we have developed such as 'plug assist' equipment for sheet forming."

"Another may wonder about the best possible plastic

to use for the job he has in mind and asks about a new formulation. So we set up equipment like his and go to work.

"Another may want us to review new developments in the field, and we frequently conduct courses right in his plant for production people and for supervision. Or we conduct courses in our own facilities for hundreds of visitors from the United States and abroad."

The work involves every industrial field and a wide range of plastic materials. Dr. Goggin said term e aerorETAO zin said there are more than 7000 uses for polystyrene alone.
